# Dr. Wingyan Chung Ranked Among Top 20 Researchers Globally

FSU professor Dr. Wingyan Chung is ranked among the top 20 researchers globally in Business Intelligence and Analytics (BI&A), according to an article published in MIS Quarterly, a top-tier academic journal in MIS, information science, and computer science. The article, titled “Business Intelligence and Analytics: From Big Data to Big Impact,” (full text available at [http://ksl.unctsu.edu/doc/BIA\\_Rsch\\_MISQ12.pdf](http://ksl.unctsu.edu/doc/BIA_Rsch_MISQ12.pdf)) was published in the December 2012 issue of MIS Quarterly. The journal had the highest impact factor (4.978) of all peer-reviewed academic journals in the field of Business from 1992 to 2005. The journal’s impact factor for 2011 was 4.447.

BI&A is identified in 2011 “IBM Tech Trends Report” as one of four major technology trends in 2010. McKinsey Global Institute predicted that by 2018, the U.S. will face a shortage of 140,000 to 190,000 people with deep BI&A skills, as well as a shortfall of 1.5 million data-savvy managers with the know-how in BI&A to analyze big data to make effective decisions.

Dr. Wingyan Chung is an Associate Professor of MIS at the School of Business and Economics at Fayetteville State University. At FSU, he

has taught data analytics, business intelligence, database management, and introductory MIS courses. He also is the founder and director of the Knowledge Systems Laboratory (<http://ksl.uncfsu.edu/>) that fosters research and educational developments in BI&A, cyber security, and knowledge systems development and validation. Dr. Chung received a Research Fellow Award from FSU in 2012.

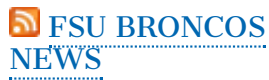
